Wastewater Treatment Facilities

There are 8 municipal wastewater treatment facilities in Crawford County. The operators of these facilities are required to submit a Compliance and Maintenance Annual Report (CMAR) to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR). A point score is calculated by the DNR for only the CMAR sections that apply to a specific wastewater treatment works. The point score from each section is used to determine the Grade Point Average (GPA). The meaning of the GPA and response range are explained below
